Common Customs Portal in Works

New Delhi: The government is planning to launch a Common Customs Electronic Portal to provide all trade-related information and facilities for importers and exporters, and improve ease of doing business. The proposed portal will facilitate registration, filing of bills of entry, shipping bills, payment of duty, and viewing and response to show cause notices, audits and other related inquiries by customs authorities, sources told ET. The new portal will be a combination of existing Indian Customs Electronic Gateway (Icgate), which provides electronic filing services to cargo carriers and other trading partners, and the existing single window interface for trade (Switri), so that all trade-related information is at one single location, one of the sources said. —Gulveen Aulakh & Kirtika Suneja

Steady Policy Direction, Intrepid Reform Instinct

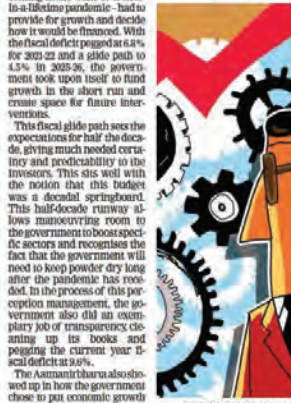
The Union Budget was dubbed by many on social media as Atmanirbhar Bharat Ka Budget. True to the title, the government chose to put skin in the game, with concrete ambitions and steady policy direction and intrepid reform instincts. The biggest takeaway was that the government chose to hold on to the path of Atmanirbhar from the front. The government chose to undertake difficult things itself - managing perceptions, promising tough reforms, working on procedural paradigm shifts and mindset change inside the administration. The government has also outlined its own role in economic growth but also catalysed the revival of animal spirits. The foremost statement of Atmanirbhar was the government ignoring the noise on fiscal deficit. The budget - coming in the wake of a one-to-a-lifetime pandemic - had to provide for growth and decide how it would be financed. With the fiscal deficit pegged at 8% for 2021-22 and a glide path to 4.5% in 2025-26, the government took upon itself to fund growth in the short run and create space for future interventions.

financial sector woes. While the foreign institutional investments in the sector will be encouraged, the government closed loop on two important local institutional frameworks. A dedicated financial institution (DFI) and an asset reconstruction company (ARC) - were announced to be set up. The DFI to be set up under an act of the Parliament, will have a wide remit on funding the National Infrastructure Pipeline. The ARC will absorb the stressed assets from bank balance sheets, especially public sector banks. The timing for the ARC is apt given that banks may see increase in stressed assets due to Covid-19 induced losses. The reform momentum to reduce administrative discretion and increase ease of doing business continued in this budget through significant

The Asmanirbhar also showed up in how the government chose to put economic growth as its singular objective. The budget demonstrated a realisation that deficit does not lead to the outcome of policymaking, not the object of policymaking in itself. The same concept was applied to assets, which stabilises income of the economic activity rather than stand-alone activity in itself. This thinking is a fundamental shift in the emphasis on output and outcomes. The promise made on divestment and asset monetisation was another big example of Atmanirbhar. Hitherto, divestment and asset monetisation have been seen from the lens of yearly non-tax revenue receipts. This budget made a structural shift in being not a well-defined reading on how the government looks at central public sector enterprises (CPSE). The government looks to exit all non-strategic CPSE. This will be achieved via privatisation or simply shutting down loss-making units. Even within the four identified strategic business areas, a commitment has been made to retain only a few public sector firms. The budget also talked about privatising two public sector banks and one general insurance firm. Similar ambitions were also demonstrated on asset monetisation. CPSEs like the National Highways Authority of India and Power Grid Corporation are coming up with their IFRs, designed to unlock value of their operational and profitable assets. Such value unlocking is possible and the government now seeks to bridge that gap, also through monetisation of assets like CPSEs' idle land. Another facet of Atmanirbhar was the long-term planning ground addressing the fi-

changes in government processes. The Income Tax Appellate Tribunal Interface will become faceless and video conferencing will be used where personal appearances are required. Old income tax demands can now be opened up to three years instead of one or two years. The threshold for tax audits has been raised significantly making it easier for small businesses and professionals to manage their tax filing. All these are welcome steps and point solutions towards addressing specific pain points. Prime Minister Narendra Modi had remarked before the budget session of Parliament that the government had already delivered several mini-budgets through 2020. This budget indeed provided policy continuity and stability. The Atmanirbhar Bharat non-economic - production linked incentives for manufacturing, defence manufacturing reforms and corporatisation, FDI policies, agriculture and labour law reforms - together with this budget provide for the biggest changes to India's economic direction since 1991. Governments should never waste a crisis as the adage goes - India has indeed taken the dream by its horns. (Views expressed are personal)

Ready to raise tariffs if any rival takes lead: Airtel CEO

Gopal Vittal noted that the industry needs tariff hike to nudge Arpu towards ₹300

Bharti Airtel—which recently declared that its network is 5G-ready—does not anticipate any material change in its capital expenditure with the advent of fifth-generation services, its CEO Gopal Vittal said on Thursday.

Addressing an investor call after announcing a strong Q3 performance, Vittal declined to comment on specific timing when tariff rates would go up, saying it is a competitive issue and based on market dynamics, but did not rule out the possibility of implementing hikes. "I believe, we will be ready to raise up tariffs if and when any player actually moves tariffs, given that we are already at a premium," he said.

Vittal maintained that the industry needs tariff hike to nudge the average realisation per user (Arpu) per month towards ₹200 initially.

and ₹300 eventually. "We would love to see tariffs go up. This is obviously something that industry needs in order to generate a reasonably good return on capital deployed...this is what would be required for the business model to succeed," Vittal said. He added that the company will

shut down its copper infrastructure in a year or so, and only have fibre to the home. "We are...in the process of rapidly upgrading our legacy copper assets completely to Fibre," he said, terming it a "game-changing move". Outlining the company's spectrum strategy, Vittal said Bharti Airtel is keen on a full footprint of

sub-GHz spectrum across the country, even as it looks to balance a combination of capacity and renewals.

"There are many circles...where we don't have a sub-GHz spectrum, so we would love to have that. There are some renewals coming up on 1,800 band, there is also some capacity spectrum available on 2,300 band where we already got deployed equipment...a combination of capacity or renewal we will look and balance it, and make sure we optimise what we do," Vittal said.

His comments came at a time when the government has set the ball rolling for the spectrum auction, in which radio waves valued at ₹3.92 trillion will be put on the block. The auction in seven spectrum bands for mobile services—700, 800, 900, 1,800, 2,100, 2,300 and 2,500MHz bands—is scheduled to start from 1 March. Bharti Airtel has logged net profit of ₹854 crore for December quarter against ₹1,035 crore loss a year ago.

Covid, chronic drugs drive domestic pharma sales in Q3

Covid-19 drugs and chronic drugs such as anti-diabetics shored up domestic sales for pharmaceutical companies in the October-December quarter.

Consolidated net profits of Sun Pharmaceutical Industries Ltd, Lupin Ltd and Cipla Ltd during the quarter doubled from a year ago, with sales growth in India aided primarily by chronic drugs for the first two and covid-19 medicines for Cipla. Dr Reddy's Laboratories had a weak quarter compared to the other three, primarily because of a ₹600 crore impairment on certain products it had acquired. However, its Indian operations posted strong sales growth.

US sales growth of the four Indian pharmaceutical giants varied between 3% and 7%, as the market continued its recovery following the coronavirus outbreak.

Sun Pharma posted domestic sales of ₹2,753 crore, up 9.4% from a year ago as India's largest drugmaker, aided by

sales of chronic drugs. The management in its investor conference call said that medical representatives have resumed fieldwork, with almost all doctors restarting practice but patient visits are still 70-75% of pre-covid levels.

"India sales was bolstered by the chronic portfolio while acute remains weak, because of few doctor-patient visits," Elara Securities (India) Pvt. Ltd said about Sun Pharma.

Lupin Ltd also showed growth because of its chronic portfolio. The company said that anti-diabetic, cardiac and

central nervous system drugs registered robust growth. India sales were up 5% at ₹1,370 crore, with chronic drugs sales, which make up 65% of the company's domestic revenue, growing 12.9%.

"We remain positive on the long-term outlook considering strong chronic presence in India and a decent US pipeline," ICICI Securities said.

Cipla's strong performance in the Indian market during the quarter was aided primarily by its covid-19 drugs portfolio, but analysts raised concerns over whether or not it would continue, especially as daily new cases in India are declining.

"With covid incidences in India on a significant decline, the covid portfolio should sharply taper off in Q4 FY21, which should only be partially offset by an increase in growth rates for base portfolio imminently. As Cipla has a larger dependence on acute drugs compared to peers, there is a fair chance that base portfolio growth may take longer to return to normalcy," Vishal Manchanda, an analyst at Nirmal Bang Institutional Equities, said in a report about Cipla.

BigBasket's FY20 losses widen 26% ahead of stake sale

Online grocer BigBasket's parent company, Supermarket Grocery Supplies Pvt. Ltd, saw its losses widen by 26% to ₹709 crore in 2019-20 from ₹562 crore in the previous fiscal, according to documents sourced from business information platform Tofler.

While total revenue grew to ₹3,818 crore in FY20 from ₹2,802 crore in FY19, expenses jumped 31% to ₹4,411 crore from ₹3,365 crore during the period.

This comes at a time when the Tata group is in the final stages of buying a majority stake in BigBasket for \$1.3 billion, valuing the e-grocer at \$1.6 billion. *Mint* reported last month.

The Tatas may pick the stake from existing shareholders, including Chinese retail giant Alibaba, besides others, and is also looking to infuse fresh capital in BigBasket. Goldman Sachs and Morgan Stanley were appointed as bankers to the potential deal.

In an industry event, BigBasket co-founder and chief executive Hari Menon said the company has plans to go

public in India. He added that the firm's business has doubled compared to pre-covid levels.

BigBasket is facing strong competition from Amazon Fresh, Flipkart, Grofers and Reliance Retail's JioMart, which are upping their ante in the much-contested e-grocery space. Even food delivery platform, Swiggy, has introduced instant grocery deliveries through its offering, Instamart.

India's online grocery business was pegged at \$3 billion by management consultancy firm, RedSeer. With the market charting an annual growth rate (CAGR) of 37%, this is expected to reach \$18.2 billion by 2024, RedSeer said.

Online ticketing site BookMyShow on Friday will launch a pay-per-view video streaming service, BookMyShow Stream, where movies can be rented or bought for ₹40-600 depending on the title.

BookMyShow has tied up with American studios such as Sony Pictures, Warner Bros and Universal Pictures, Indian production houses like Viacom18, Shemaroo and Rajshri Productions as well as regional content providers like Divo and Sillymonks for the service.

At its launch, its library has

600 movies including Christopher Nolan's *Tenet*, Gal Gadot starrer *Wonder Woman 1984*, horror fantasy *The Craft: Legacy* and Russian science fiction thriller *Coma*. In the next 9-12 months, BookMyShow aims to offer up to 2,000 films including Hollywood, independent and foreign cinema.

A film on rent will be available for 30 days and once started, must be finished viewing within 48 hours. A title can be purchased for six months or even longer. The service will be available for viewing on BookMyShow's mobile app and website as well as Apple TV, Android TV, Firestick, Chromecast and desktop browsers.

Now, cops launch 'Mrityunjay Doot' initiative to save accident victims

Highway Traffic Police aims to bring down accident fatalities by 10% through this plan

Maharashtra Highway Police will be launching a statewide initiative Mrityunjay Doot across all national and State highways in Maharashtra. As part of this initiative, the police will rope in local villagers, dhaba walas, petrol pump walas, doctors and hospitals to make optimum use of the golden hour in case of an accident. The police will also be providing training to the locals on how to administer first aid in case of an accident. The police intend to prepare 1,500 people as Doots across the state. This initiative is launched with an intention to bring down fatal accidents on the highways.

"Whenever an accident takes place, the most important thing that comes into play is the Golden Hour. It is the most precious hour in which the injured has to be



administered medical treatment. Currently, it takes anywhere around 90 minutes to two hours to rush an injured to a medical care centre. Also, we have seen that locals who mostly act as first responders do not know what are the basic first aid and medical steps that need to be followed to save an injured person. Our target is to bring down the fatal accidents by ten per cent. From March, we would start an initiative

known as Mrityunjay Doot across the state wherein we would work towards bringing down the numbers of death in accident cases," said additional director general of police, state highway traffic, Dr BK Upadhyay. Explaining more about this initiative, Dr Upadhyay said, "Under this initiative we would rope in highway police, local police, health department bod-

icals, dhaba walas, toll naka walas, petrol pump staffers and villagers who would work as Mrityunjay Doots. We will give them basic training on how to respond when there is an accident and would also provide stretchers to them which they can use during an emergency. We intend to create a force of 1500 Mrityunjay Doots and would also provide I-Cards to them and we would also appreciate and reward their work. I would also like to inform you that anyone who helps an injured person will not be harassed either by the police or by the hospital." As per the police, most fatal accident cases are witnessed in Nashik, Pune, Ahmednagar, Solapur and Latur. There are 98 national highways and 378 state highways which are currently being manned by 3000 police personnel from the highway police.

Court refuses to accept closure report against gangster Chhota Rajan, 5 others

A special court designated under the Maharashtra Control of Organized Crime Act (MCOCA) has rejected the CBI's plea for the court to accept a closure report in a 2005 murder case in which former underworld don Chhota Rajan and five others are accused. The CBI's Investigating Officer had submitted along with the closure report that no strong case worth prosecution is made out against

Chhota Rajan and other co-accused. The statements of material witnesses cannot be treated as reliable and trustworthy, the officer had stated. Also, that mere business rivalry cannot be a strong motive for murder. He had further pointed out that witnesses had turned hostile in trial against the arrested accused earlier. The court said in its order while rejecting the closure report that whether the witnesses are reliable and trustworthy can only be testified by

way of evidence. Special Judge AT Wankhede went ahead and took cognizance of the offences against the accused, concluding that there is sufficient material to proceed against the accused. It said that the statements of the witnesses clearly point out the involvement of Rajan and others in the offence. The fact that the witnesses turned hostile in the trial against the arrested accused, it said, is not sufficient to accept the report of the IO of the CBI.



Man held for raping minor, making video

The Kurla police have arrested a 35-year-old man a month after he allegedly raped a 12-year-old girl from his vicinity. The accused (name withheld) who has a salon in the same area allegedly made a video clip of the incident, and threatened the girl with dire consequences if she disclosed the incident to anyone.

According to the police, the incident came to light last week when a relative of the accused saw the video clip in his mobile phone. Since his relative stays in the same area, he immediately identified the girl from his neighborhood and alerted the victim's family members.

After learning about her daughter's ordeal, mother approached the Kurla police station. Soon after the incident was reported to the police station, the police arrested the accused.

BIRD FLU IN MAHARASHTRA

1,619 more birds found dead

Mumbai

A total of 1,619 birds including 1,445 poultry birds died due to avian influenza in Maharashtra. The samples are being sent to National Institute of High Security Animal Diseases, Bhopal and Disease Investigation Section, Pune for testing. A total of 20,372 deaths of various birds have been recorded till date since January 8.



According to the department of animal husbandry, so far 72,170 poultry birds, 44,686 eggs and 63,339 kg poultry feed have been scientifically destroyed from

infected zones with a radius of 1 km from the poultry farms. Surveillance work is continued at the places where positive results have been reported in other species of birds excluding poultry. The process of collection of Cloacal and oro-pharyngeal swabs, dropping and serum samples of the birds from the 1-10 km radius area from the infected zones will be initiated after issuing the sanitization certificate.

8-yrs-jail term for man who stabbed wife for eating curd

While showing leniency to the accused, the sufferings of the victim cannot be ignored, stated the judge

A sessions court on Monday sentenced a 39-year-old man to eight years rigorous imprisonment for stabbing his wife with a kitchen knife in her abdomen for eating curd.

Judge Sanjivsinh J. Gharat while deciding the quantum of sentence said in her judgment that the offence proved against Sachin Malore is serious in nature. While showing leniency to the accused, the sufferings of the victim cannot be ignored, the judge stated.

"The accused stabbed his own wife on petty ground," the court said, but considered that the incident took place in a rage of anger and spur of moment and was not premeditated. The court also considered that he has no criminal antecedents and had been in custody for his arrest in 2017 for three years.

During the trial, his wife Ranjana Malore had de-

posed before the court how her husband, an alcoholic, would pick quarrels and beat her over trivial issues. On September 9, 2017, the family had returned from their native place. Ranjana's mother had packed her some curd, which she was eating, when her husband picked a fight with her over eating it and stabbed her with a kitchen knife. She raised an alarm and her landlord's son-in-law, who lived above, came to her rescue. Her husband fled. She then made a phone call with the help of the man to her elder sister who resides nearby. Her sister then covered her stomach with a towel and took her to Sion hospital. The hospital informed the police and a complaint was lodged.

2015 COP ASSAULT CASE

Court acquits 4, says evidence of cops does not inspire confidence

Acquitting four persons in a case of assaulting and threatening an on-duty police station incharge in 2015, a sessions court pointed out several discrepancies in the evidence of police before it and said their evidence does not inspire confidence.

As per the complaint filed by Swati Khedkar who was incharge of Nehru Nagar police station, on January 18, 2015, the four persons Zubeda Nisar, Febin Shaikh, Nisar Ahmed and Kadar Shaikh had come into her cabin. Zubeda had questioned Khedkar why her brother Arif Shaikh had been brought to the

station. Khedkar had explained that he was brought in connection with a motor accident case in which he had not paid the fine. Zubeda had allegedly started shouting, caught Khedkar's collar and slapped her while Febin had scuffed and the other two had threatened her. The prosecution had examined five witnesses, of which four were police and an independent witness who did not support its case. Adhoc Assistant Sessions Judge CP Jain said in her judgment that if the evidence is minutely scrutinized, it will reflect that there is no consistency in the oral evidence of all the prosecution witnesses.

Youth dies after accidentally drinking thinner instead water, manager held

The Kandivli police arrested the manager of a factory after a 19-year-old youth working there died after drinking thinner instead of water at the factory recently. During the investigation it was revealed that the water bottle was placed exactly besides the thinner bottle which caused the confusion. The manager is identified as Baburam Verma, 26, who was arrested for causing death by negligence.

The incident took place on January 24 when Kashinath Yakappa a laborer along with another worker was doing a paint job at the factory. Accidentally they both drank thinner instead of water. According to the police, Yakappa fell unconscious while the other employee did not suffer much. He was rushed to the nearby hospital for treatment however he did not survive and died during treatment the next day, said police.
